Dear Gordon

The Carnoustie Golf Hotel has been selected by the organising committee of the Commonwealth Games 2014 to be used as a satellite village for athletes competing in the shooting competition being held at Barry Buddon.

The Commonwealth Games agreement requires each satellite village to mirror as closely as possible the main Games Village in terms of facilities, services and security for the athletes residing there.

To comply with the above we have agreed for the Commonwealth Games organising committee to have exclusive use of the Hotel from 9th July 2014 until 3rd August 2014 inclusive.

This means that only Commonwealth Games accredited personnel will be allowed access to any part of the Hotel during the period 9th July – 3rd August 2014.

Unfortunately this means that Dalhousie Golf Club members and regular patrons will not have access to the hotel or facilities during the exclusive use period.

The selection of the Hotel by the Commonwealth Games organising committee as a satellite village represents a significant investment both in our Hotel and in the Carnoustie area, and we are delighted to be able to contribute toward what will be another huge opportunity to showpiece Scotland across the world in the sporting year of 2014.

I thank you in advance for your understanding, and of course Morag Fraser who will be our Project Manager liaising with the Games representatives, or myself will be pleased to provide any further information or answer any questions you may have.
